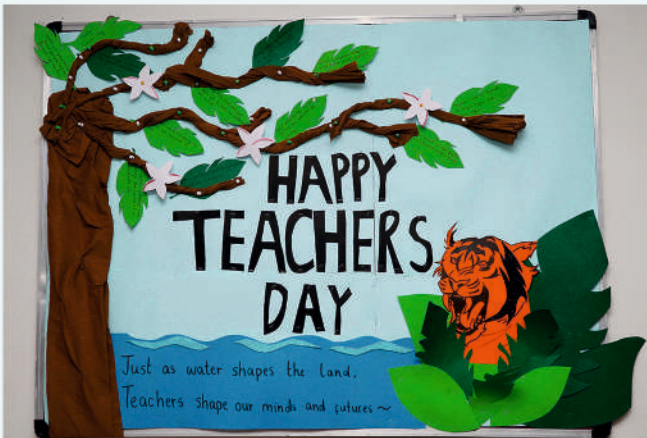
ONAM CELEBRATION

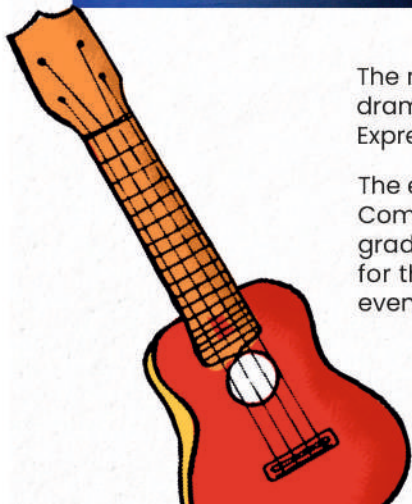


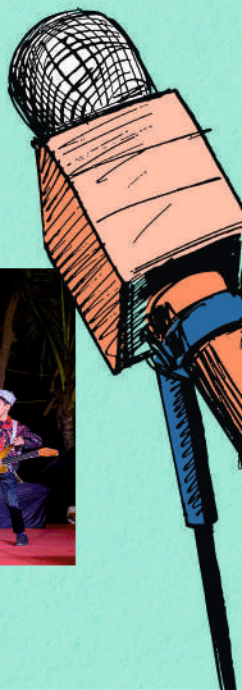
ANNUAL DAY CELEBRATION

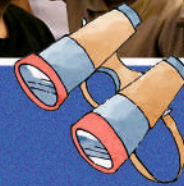
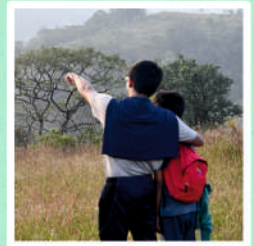




POST OFFICE VISIT

ZOO FIELD TRIP



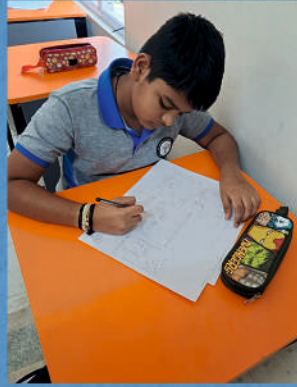

Article on Rajinikanth


Rajinikanth, born on 12th December 1950, is an Indian actor who works in Tamil cinema. In a career spanning over 5 decades, he has done 170 films that include films in Tamil, Hindi, Telugu, Kannada, Bengali and Malayalam.

He is widely regarded to be one of the most successful and popular actors in the history of Indian cinema. Known for his uniquely styled mannerisms and one liners in films, he has a huge fan base internationally and has developed a cult following.

The government of India honoured him with the Padma Bhushan in 2000 and the Padma Vibhushan in 2016, two of India's highest civilian honours. Additionally, he received various high level awards in the National film awards ceremony of 2019 for his contributions to Indian cinema. He has won many film awards, including seven Tamil Nadu state film awards, a Nandi award and a Filmfare award.

His most recent blockbuster Jailer, one of the highest-grossing Indian films of 2023, made a significant impact in the Tamil film industry. It earned over ₹600 crore with him as the main lead. He now has two ₹500 crore grosser films in the industry.

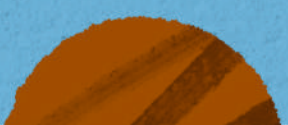
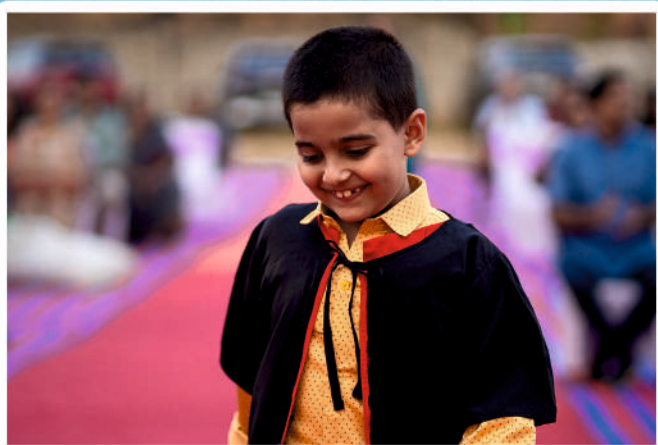
KINDERGARTEN GRADUATION CEREMONY
